Nothing motivates people like a challenge and photographers are no exception to that rule. We are creative, inspired, goal-driven individuals who love a reason to take something to the next level.

Back in October, my good friend **David Jones** and I were speaking to the Twin Cities PPA about preparing for their upcoming print competition. As we came to the end of the program, I suggested to those in attendance how lucky we all are to be in such a wonderful profession that allows us to make a living doing what we love and if our program was of any help to them, they should consider making a donation to PPA Charities. Then I blurted out "if you can put \$500 on the table before the end of the night, I will let you shave my head at the next meeting!"

After a few laughs and some veiled threats from a few members about writing a check for the full amount, I left the meeting with

my hair intact. A few days later, TCPPA President **Mark Kiefer** called. "How serious were you about the offer to shave your head?" We chatted about ways to raise money and came up with an idea; it would be presented at the print competition in November.

Since there are no entry fees on the TCPPA level, members were challenged to donate \$25 per case to PPA Charities. At that rate, 30 cases would bring \$750. If that goal was reached, my previous offer would stand.

The TCPPA membership came through in a huge way, generously raising \$2,200 in donations. The Association itself added another \$1,000 to the total and presented me with a check for \$3,200 on the evening of the holiday party! To top it off, another \$300 was generated on the evening of the party by those in attendance who wanted their turn with the clipper!

At the conclusion of the evening, I left the event with a bald head, a huge smile and over \$3,500 was raised for PPA Charities!
